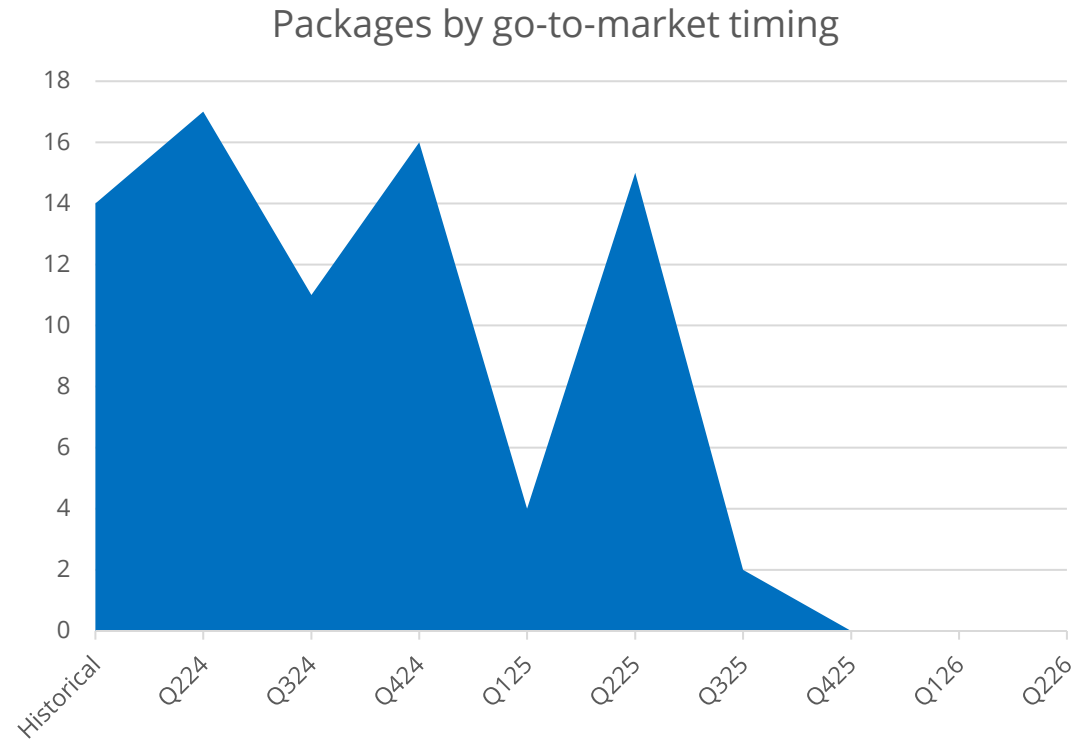
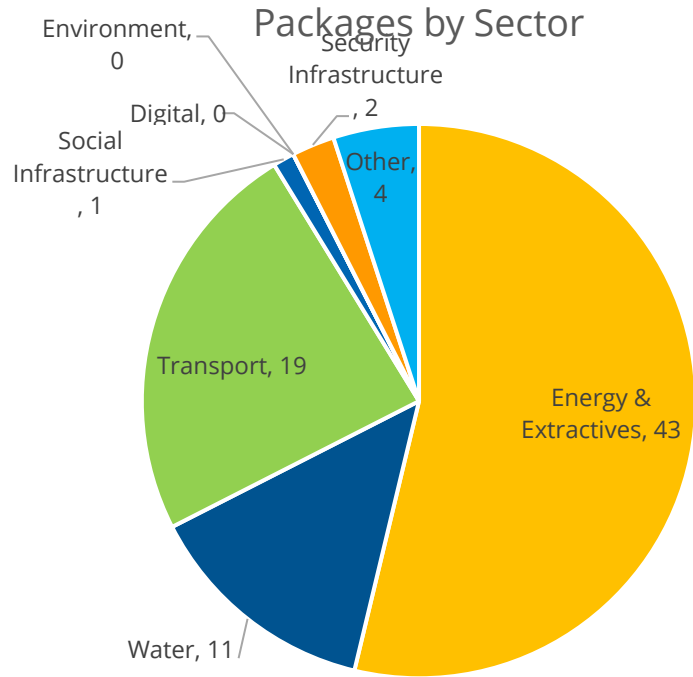

MAJOR PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

PNG High level Development Goal as per Medium Term Development Plan 2023 – 2027:
To increase GDP to K200 Billion (US\$50 Billion) from K54 Billion and create 1 million jobs
by 2030

***Sector Specific Objective: To improve transport and utilities infrastructure through
Connect PNG programmes to achieve development targets such as increased electricity
access from 19% to 70% by 2027***

 - *Objective - Upgraded to 17 Megawatts.*

- 3. Rehabilitation and Upgrades in Selected Substation (WB)**
 - To be tendered on Q2 2025

Connect PNG – Transport Infrastructures

National Department of Works and Highways (ADB)

- Improvement of regional roads in PNG Highlands
 - Market approach TBC

PNG Ports

- Kavieng and Kimbe Port Upgrades (DFAT/AIFFFP)
 - To be tendered on Q2 2025
- Focus on local content, social safeguards and seismic and climate change resilience

LOCAL PARTICIPATION OPPORTUNITIES

- The size of the civil works packages vary from USD50,000 to USD92 million, so there are opportunities for contractors of different size and capability.
- For example, construction of Control Tower in Gokora it is likely to attract PNG Contractors only.
- Also, several large contracts will factor in local content in evaluation criteria.

Transparency: 57 packages are scheduled to go through open tender
