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



CURRENT SITUATION OF HUMAN RESOURCES



Psychiatrist: 0,62/100.000

- Nurse: 3/100000
- **Psychological workers**
 - 3% of clinicians in public hospitals (8 mental health doctors and 20 mental health nurses with 1 psychological worker)
 - ✤ 37/63 provinces do not have any psychological worker
 - ✤ 6.5% of caregivers in social well-fair centers have a psychological education background
 - ✤ 2/3 of school counselors are unprofessional

Social workers

- ✤ 0,04 social workers per 100,000 population
- In Rehabilitation centers for people with mental illnesses: 10% of caregivers have education in social work; 50% have not experience in mental health



CURRENT SITUATION OF HUMAN RESOURCES



- Lack of quantity and quality of high-quality human resources
- Mostly concentrated in the Red River Delta (Hanoi) and Ho Chi Minh City; There are very few in Northern mountainous areas, the Central Highlands and the Western region
- Lack of structure: nursing; special education teacher; social worker
- There is no human resource data in: facilities under the Ministry of Labor, Invalids and Social Affairs; school health; facility under the Ministry of Public Security and National Defense..



CURRENT STATUS OF TRAINING HUMAN RESOURCES - TRAINING FACILITIES



- Total number of universities offering medical training: 30 (HN University of Medicine-1902; Tra Vinh University-2021)
- Total number of full-time lecturers: 89
- Total number lecture tablets invite lecture : 200
- Associate Professor/Professor: 15
- PhD/Specialits 2:40



CURRENT STATUS OF TRAINING HUMAN RESOURCES IN HEALTHCARE



- Training facilities: unevenly distributed
- Lecturers: quantity and quality
- Training program: full kind of curriculum but focuses on under-graduate; now more post-graduate
- Continuous Medical Education on mental health: not given adequate attention

Health sector

- More than 11,000 CHSs but only 49% are able to perform 80% of assigned techniques
- CHSs provides free-of-charge drugs for schizophrenia, epilepsy, and depression; are not able to offer other services such as screening, treatment, relapse prevention, rehabilitation
- CHSs must rely on DHC's support to maintain mental health services
- More than 30,000 private clinics but need more mental health clinics

Social sector

- Community-based social assistance and recovery program from 2011
 - Faced challenges in multi-sectoral coordination
 - Social work centers in 36 cities, provinces; rural people with mental disorders have difficulty in access to services

Education sector

- 50% of schools have a health office, 40% of school health workers meet requirements
- 100% of students are insured but do not have access to appropriate mental care



RECOMENDATION



• Service delivery

- Expand coverage
- Transform the service delivery model
 - Integrated, coordinated care
 - Day care, community-based care
 - Bio-psychological care
 - Inter-disciplinary care

Workforce development and coordination

- Joint, comprehensive planning
- Increase quantities
- Assure quality
- Coordinate disciplines, regions, levels
