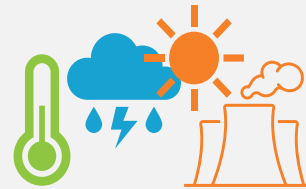

UCCRTF Lessons Learned

Shift from merely climate proofing physical assets to more holistic and integrated approaches is more effective in building systemic resilience



Mainstreaming resilience into **policies, frameworks, and regulations** ensures downstream activities align with the government's climate change objectives.



Embedding resilience at the project **conceptualization** stage is the best entry point for achieving wider impacts.



Participatory and bottom-up approaches ensure that resilience benefits reach the most vulnerable groups.



Use of **climate risk information tools and methodologies** supports evidence-based decision-making.



Upstream work on climate change resilience creates an enabling environment for **private sector investment**

Urban Resilience Trust Fund (URTF)

- The Urban Resilience Trust Fund (URTF) is a £68.5m multi-donor trust fund (2023–2031).
- Build capacity of cities and communities to integrate climate resilience into policies, and to support to develop and effectively implement a pipeline of resilience projects through public or private investments.
- Strengthen adaptation and resilience in the Indo-Pacific Region with a focus on systemic policy change, mobilizing finance, and supporting innovative approaches.

2. Investment plan for urban resilience

Nusantara GREEN: Growing Resilience and Ensuring Equity in Nusantara

- Nusantara Capital Authority (OIKN)
- July 2024–June 2027

Components

1. Urban agriculture and regenerative farming techniques to enhance urban food security
2. Establishment of climate resilient schools
3. Support to community-led adaptation projects to strengthen community resilience
