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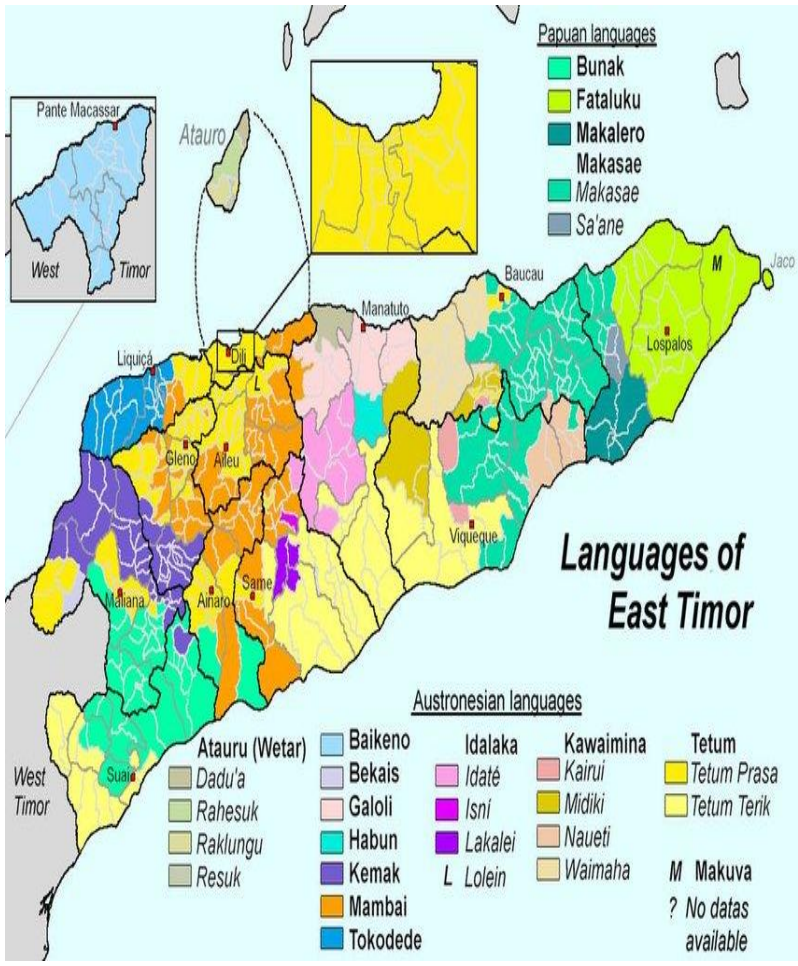

PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND

After gained the Independence in 2002, Timor-Leste Government has committed to the development of the country throughout constructions, supply goods and services in the entire nation. The country's improvement has consumed a vast amount of the nation's budget. Therefor to control the budget expenditure, the Government established a Procurement Legal Regime no. 10/2005.

CURRENT STATUS OF PROCUREMENT SECTOR

- In the exercise of its functions and tasks, the CNA implements the Decree-Law nº 22/2022, May 11th , on the Procurement Legal Regime, Public Contracts and respective Infractions. The law establishes the general rules for budget execution in the acquisition of goods, services or construction of civil works intended towards the requirements of direct or indirect Government entities.
- Almost all public procurement entities lack of qualified procurement professionals.
- Government is in the process of devising a new procurement law (Omnibus Law)
- All the procurement activities are carry out manually.

PROCUREMENT DEVELOPMENT POLICY AND STRATEGIES

- The procurement strategies and development policies is more focusing on the following sectors based on the government master plans such as : Health, Food, Infrastructures, Security, Water and Sanitations.
- The Procurement Entity always tries to advocate and promote e-procurement process among the bidders, even though the process is rare in Timor-Leste
- Government is in the process of devising a new procurement law (Omnibus Law)
- The government of Timor-Leste has been committed to implementing e-governance

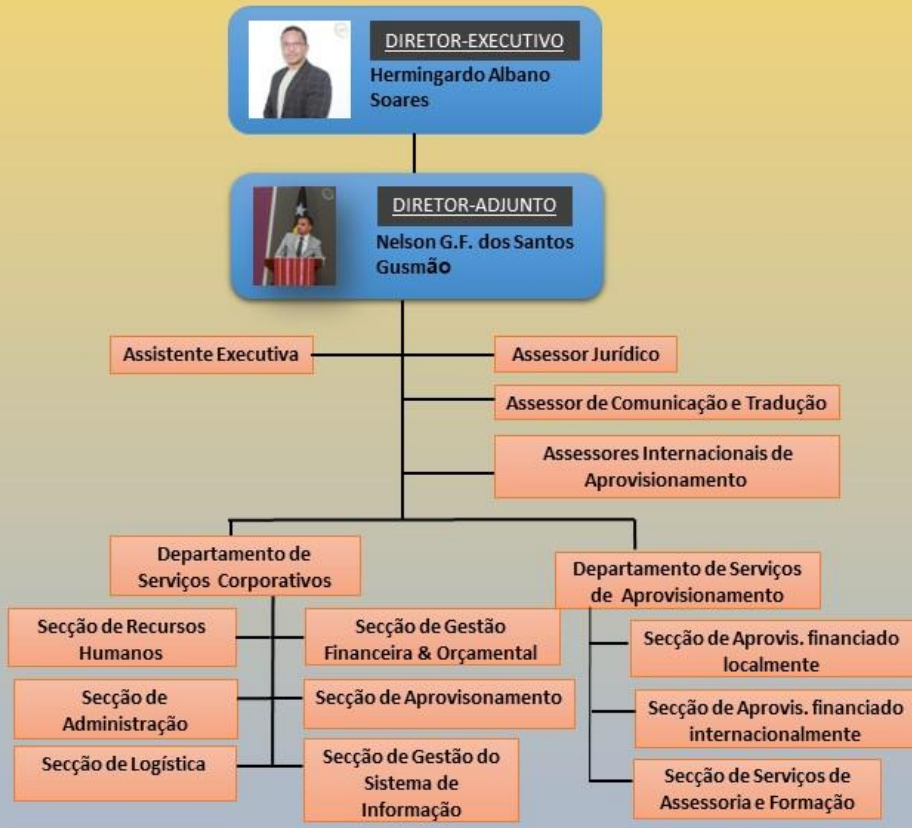

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STRUCTURE OF ORGANIZATION



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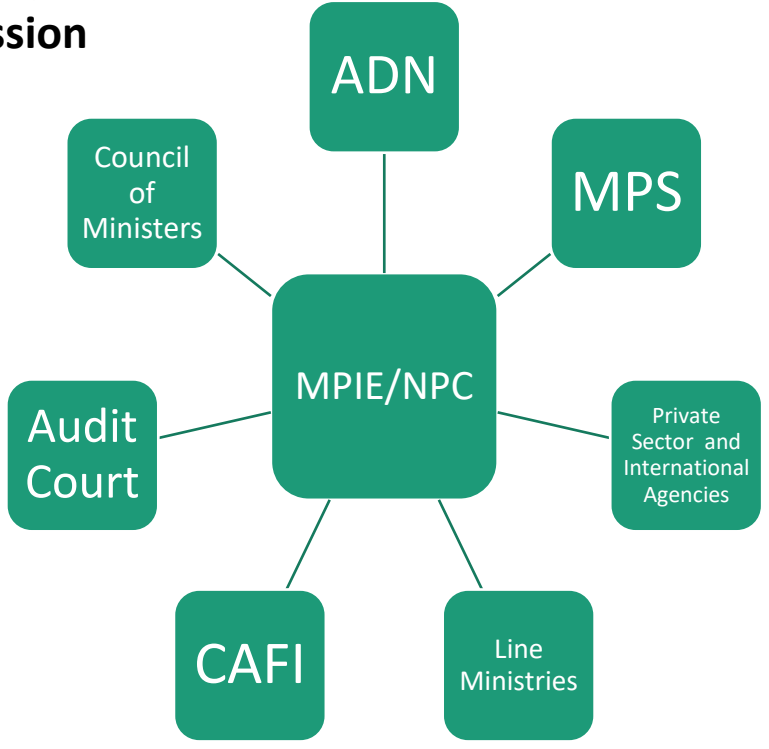


MAIN FUNCTION OF NATIONAL PROCUREMENT COMMISSION (NPC)

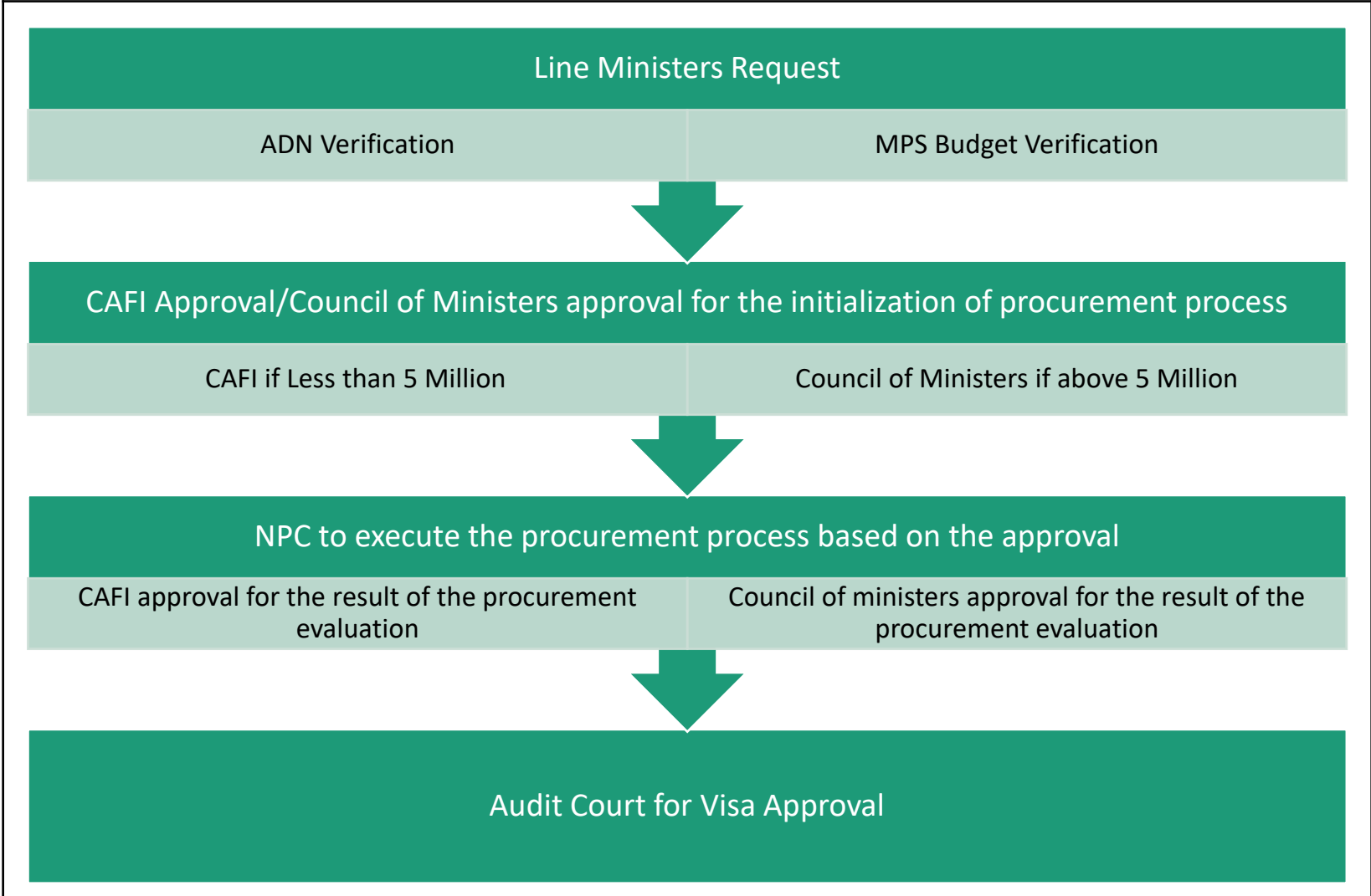
The Comissão Nacional de Aproveitamento (National Procurement Commission) was established on March 30th 2011 by the Decree-Law nº 14/2011 following the Decree-Law nº 10/2005. In 2023, the latter Decree-Law was replaced by Decree-Law nº 22/2022 where the law sought to provide improved procurement services to ministries and other public entities in large infrastructure projects and achieve proper transparency for the State's procurement process. The CNA handles the procurement of contracts utilizing the government's Infrastructure Fund regardless of amount.

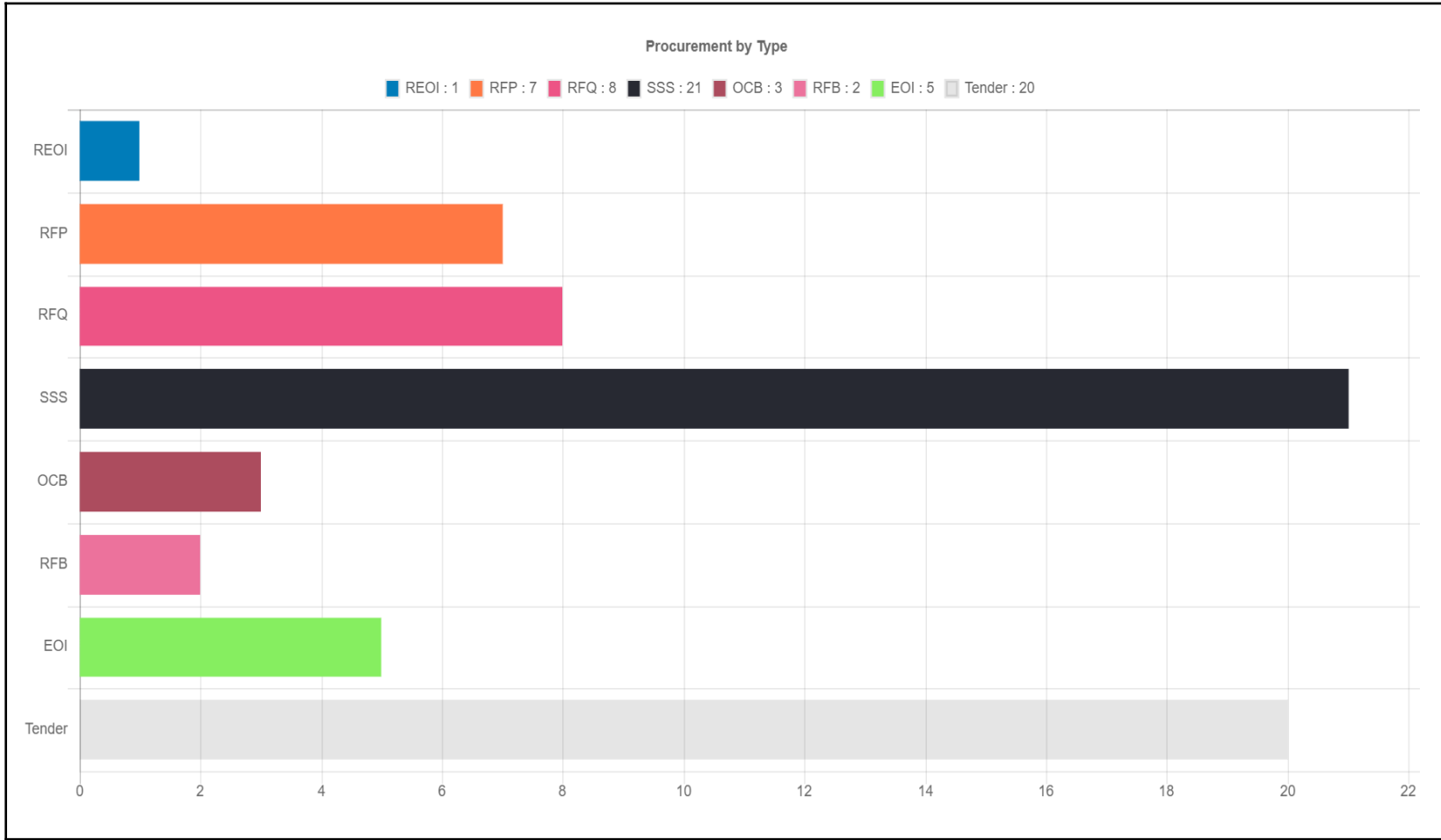

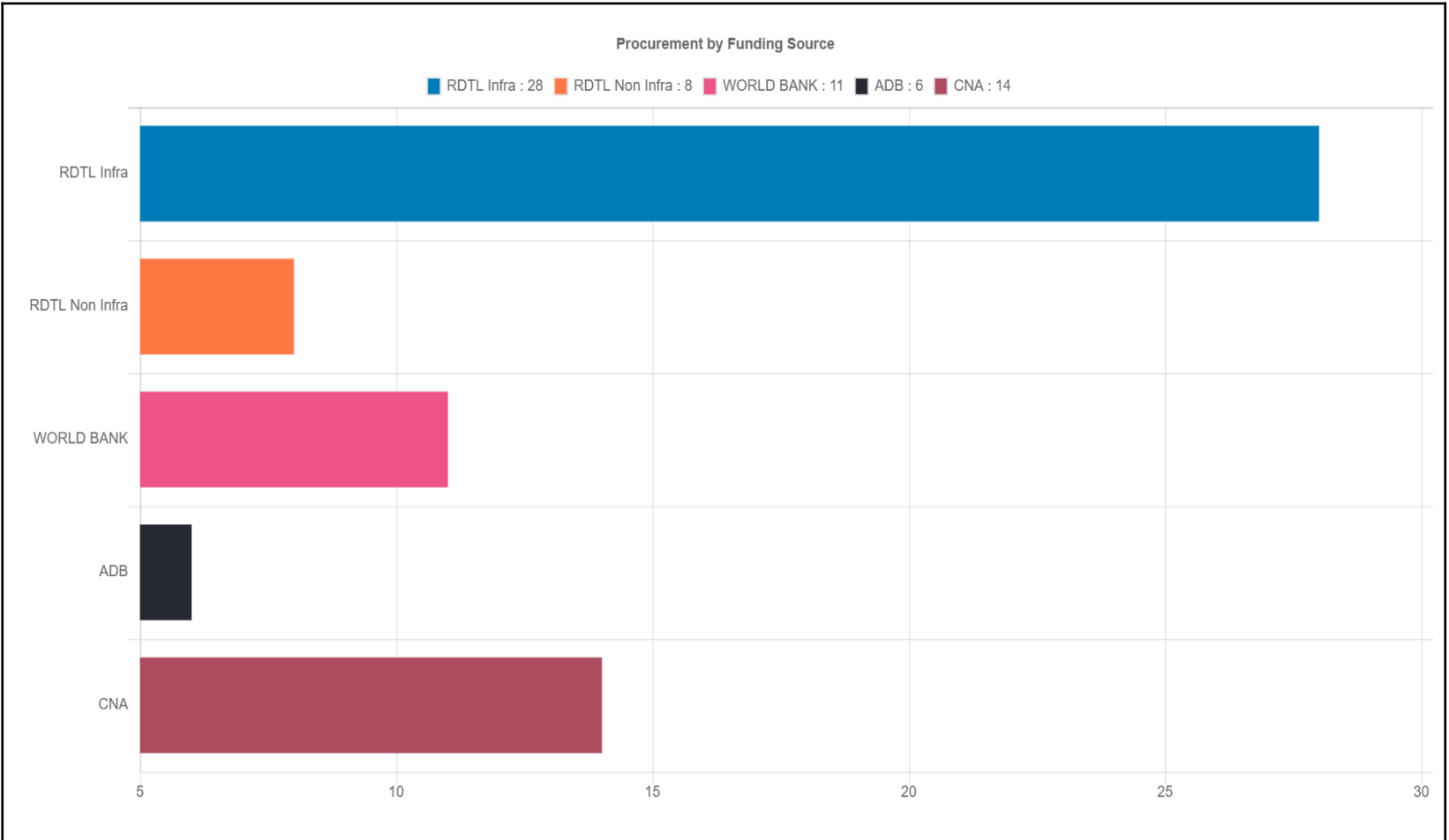
PROCUREMENT FLOW STRUCTURE
