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The Public Procurement Act, 2063 (2007)

- 67. Procurement Process under this Act not to be Applied:

the procurement process under this Act need not be applied in the following conditions:

(b) If as per the agreement between government of Nepal and donor party, procurement is to be made in accordance with the Procurement Guidelines of a donor party.

Procurement issues in Nepal

- Limited participation internationally
- Abnormally Low Bids
- Ghost Contractors
- Limited capacity in government (provinces)
- Wider BOS, Project roadshow
- More attention on Nepal Procurement Regulations (2064) Para.65
- Mandating LP's rep at site
- Capacity Development Training



Procurement issues in Nepal (Consultancy)

- Abnormally Low Bids
- Frequent replacement
- Updating quality



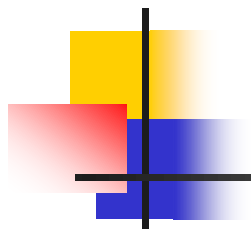
Public Investments Implementation Performance Improvement (PIIPI)

- 1) use of merit point criteria for bid evaluation for big and strategic contracts with focus on energy and transport sectors;
- 2) support upgrading of the procurement regulatory framework to promote performance based competitive bidding;
- 3) assess adoption of alternative procurement arrangements with specific government agencies;
- 4) provide recommendation for wider participation of national and international bidders in open competitive bidding advertisement;
- 5) promote sustainable public procurement to encourage social, environmental, climate and finance best practices in construction;
- 6) country / sector procurement risk assessment



Merit Point Evaluation

- Scoring on Technical Proposals
- Set up Criteria/Sub-Criteria with ratio
- Minimum score to be qualified
- Ratio with Financial Proposals
- Who evaluate/score TP (?)
- Objectivity – Scoring Guide to be prepared and detailed Bid Evaluation Report
