






Contribution of Digital

E-COMMERCE MARKET SIZE









Number of Enterprises by Province (2022)





Gender Ratio of Business Ownership




CONTRIBUTION OF SMES IN ECONOMY







Startups operate in high-risk environments, embracing uncertainty and challenges that traditional businesses might avoid.



STARTUP OVERVIEW



As of 2023, the ecosystem has 150 Active Startups, equivalent to just over 84% of the ecosystem.

Out of 129 Tech Startups, SaaS is the dominating sector with a 17.1% share. E-Commerce is the second largest with 13.95% share, together making up nearly one-third of the ecosystem.
