Representative e-Government System in Korea opening in 2002

- A single window for public procurement that electronically handles the entire procurement process
- The entire procurement process from bidding to payment is processed on one site
- On-line shopping mall with ordering and payment

- Strengthen anti-corruption of procurement process
- Achieved costs savings of 8 trillion won(≒ 6 billion USD) in annual procurement by converting procurement into electronic form


