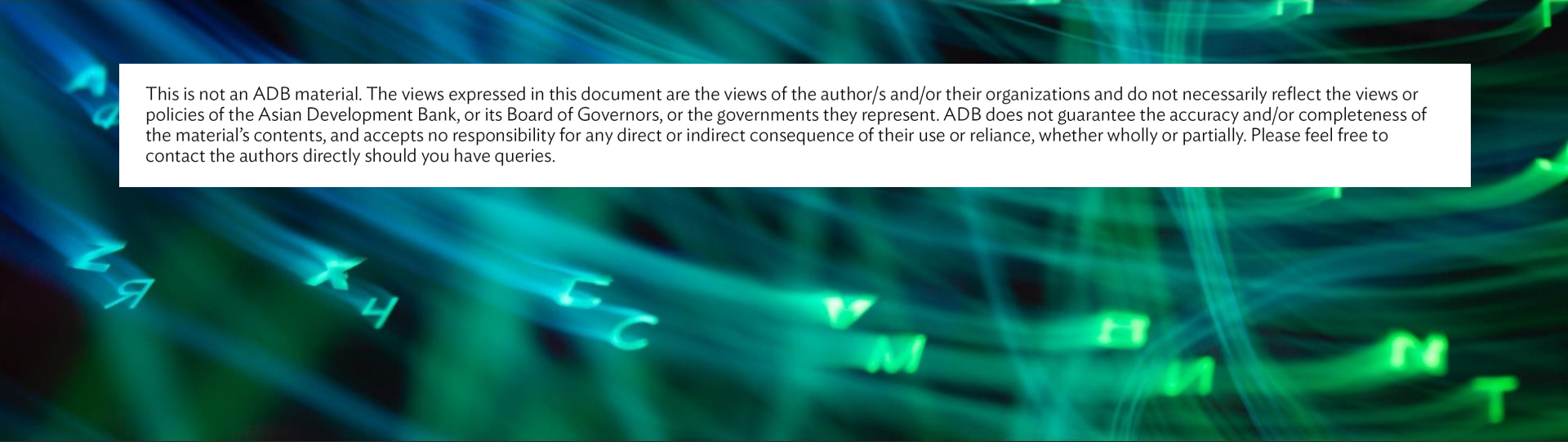

Building the ASEAN AI ecosystem

- **Building Institutional and Regulatory Foundations**

A critical element of the basic ecosystem to support AI and Gen AI development and governance involves consistent and well-implemented institutional and regulatory frameworks across ASEAN.

- **Supporting Data Development And Flows**

A need for robust data governance in the AI ecosystem and investments in data center infrastructure to support regional technological growth and address challenges in data flows across jurisdictions.

- **Enhancing Digital Literacy and Awareness**

ASEAN's transition to an AI-equipped region relies heavily on enhancing digital literacy and AI awareness through educational reforms, workforce upskilling, and robust regional plans.

- **Strengthening Regional Cooperation**

A need for enhanced international cooperation among ASEAN member states, aiming to facilitate secure and seamless data flows and establish a coherent data regulatory framework across regions.

- **Driving Interoperability**

Interoperability involves the development of universal standards, fostering technical and regulatory collaborations, and implementing secure data-exchange protocols.

- **Supporting Practical Implementation through Cross-Cutting Measures**

The importance of practical measures including regulatory sandboxes, a compendium of AI use cases and a two-step quality control process to enhance the responsible development and deployment of AI across ASEAN.

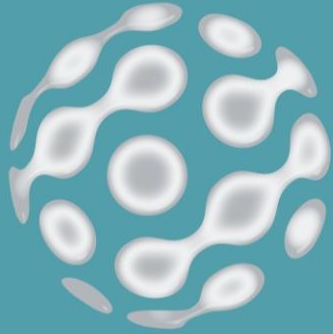
