

Sovereign Projects - Financing Types

Loans and Grants

Provided to and managed by Governments

Procurement of Works, Goods and Services

Government undertakes procurement (ADB oversight)

Contracts signed by Government

Technical Assistance

Provided to governments, but contracts managed by ADB

Mostly procurement of Consulting Services

ADB undertakes procurement

Contracts signed by ADB



Eligibility

General Requirements:

- Goods, Works, Non-Consulting and Consulting Services: Suppliers, Contractors and Consultants must be from eligible (ADB member) countries, unless otherwise agreed by ADB Board of Directors (depending on sources of fund).
- Conditions for participation shall be limited to bidders' capability to fulfill the contract.

Exceptions:

- Bidders may be excluded in compliance with a UN Security Council decision.
- Bidders in Conflict-of-Interest situations are not eligible.
- Consulting Services: Experts employed by eligible consulting firm can be from any country.
- Must not be Bidders sanctioned or suspended by ADB or other MDBs due to having involved in Fraud & Corruption are not eligible. See the list at https://lnadbg4.adb.org/oga0009p.nsf
- Government entities and staff in the Borrower's country must meet certain conditions to participate.

Advice When Approaching Opportunities

Plan ahead: Identify a pipeline of projects of interest. Understand project background, local context & partnership needs

Respond clearly to qualification and evaluation criteria Be aware of borrower systems for advertising and submission of Bids

Build local partnerships (JV or association) properly

Carefully read & understand submission requirements; no conditional bids

Understand legal
& regulatory
systems
(business
registration, tax,
customs etc.)



Common Mistakes

Bids not signed, or unclear authorization to sign

JV arrangements, structures (associate with ineligible bidders and individuals)

No compliant Bid Security

Failure to meet Qualification Criteria

Poor Supporting Documents

Incomplete Bids /
Partial Bids

Inclusion of financial offer with technical offer where bid conditions require them to be separated

Submit conditional bids

Fail to disclose Conflict of Interest

Involve in prohibited practices (integrity violations or fraud and corruption)

Submit ungrounded or frivolous complaints
