



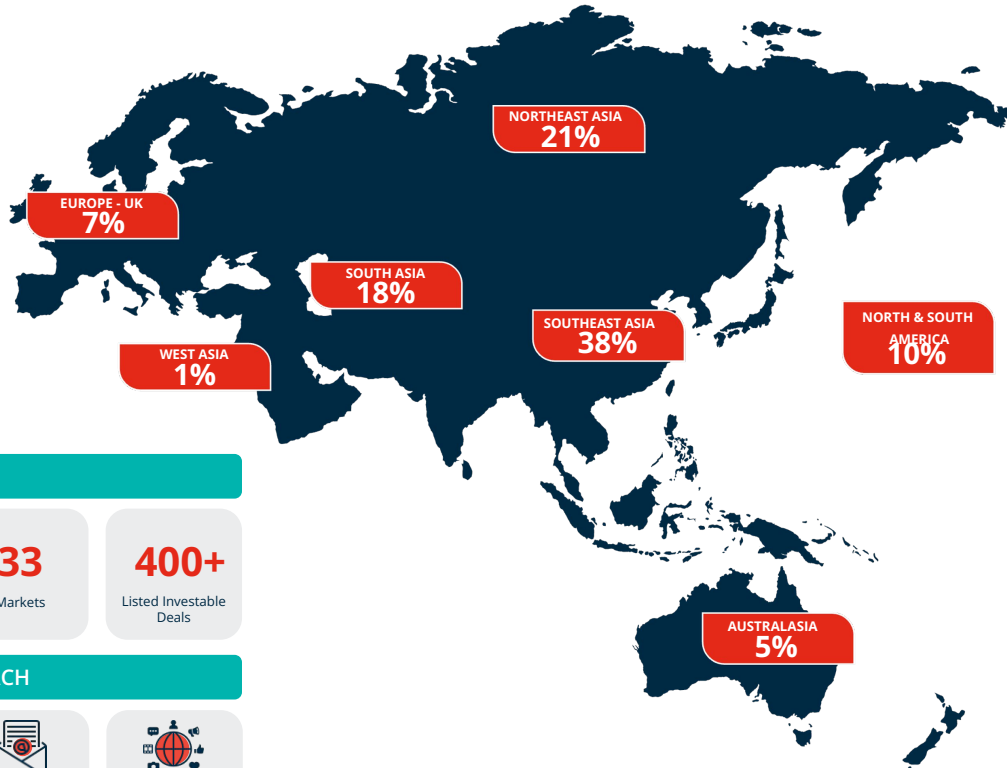

# AVPN AI Opportunity Fund: Asia-Pacific

*Empowering workers in Asia-Pacific for the AI-driven future while fostering inclusivity.*

The AI Opportunity Fund seeks to equip workers from underserved communities across Asia-Pacific with essential AI knowledge and tools. With the basic AI understanding, the workforce can adapt to the rapidly evolving landscape of AI, ensuring inclusive access to AI-driven opportunities.

## Setting the Context:

The growing use of AI is transforming industries and societies. However, many workers from underserved communities lack access to the necessary skills and tools to adapt to this change. There is an urgent need to close the skills gap and provide equitable opportunities in AI across the region.

**Ecosystem Gaps:** Currently, access to AI training is limited to certain privileged groups in most countries, excluding those who could benefit the most.

## APPROACH

### TRAIN-THE-TRAINER

Provide a comprehensive training support package by partnering with strategic AI training experts, leveraging existing AI content, and ensuring accessibility while incorporating local context.

### UNDERSTANDING LANDSCAPE

Identify underserved communities' needs and map existing AI skilling programs and resources to develop tailored, contextually relevant strategies for effective implementation of training.

### POLICY ENGAGEMENT

Foster dialogues and sharing best practices across key actors about AI skilling and Responsible AI through regional and local convenings.

### AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

Help people understand AI as an enabler of positive change and strengthen awareness of AI skilling opportunities by working with regional and local partners.

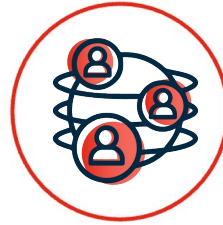
