SOURCE in Uzbekistan - PHASE 1 2019 to 2022

- SIF Engagement in Uzbekistan: SIF began working in 2019, responding to the Ministry of Finance's interest in integrating the SOURCE platform into Uzbekistan's PPP ecosystem.
- Development of a country-specific timeline and assessment module for PPP projects :
 - The digital PPP process in English and Russian has 12 primary branches based on the project origination project threshold for 272 predefined tasks.
 - Mapping of SOURCE questions against Uzbekistan's Project Concept.
 Form structure to enable an extract of SOURCE's data in appropriate local format.
- Institutionalisation of SOURCE: Phase 1 laid the groundwork for the institutionalisation of SOURCE, supporting the government's efforts to strengthen the PPP framework.

• Need for an online platform to increase the visibility of Uzbekistan's PPP framework and promote opportunities to a broader marketplace.







