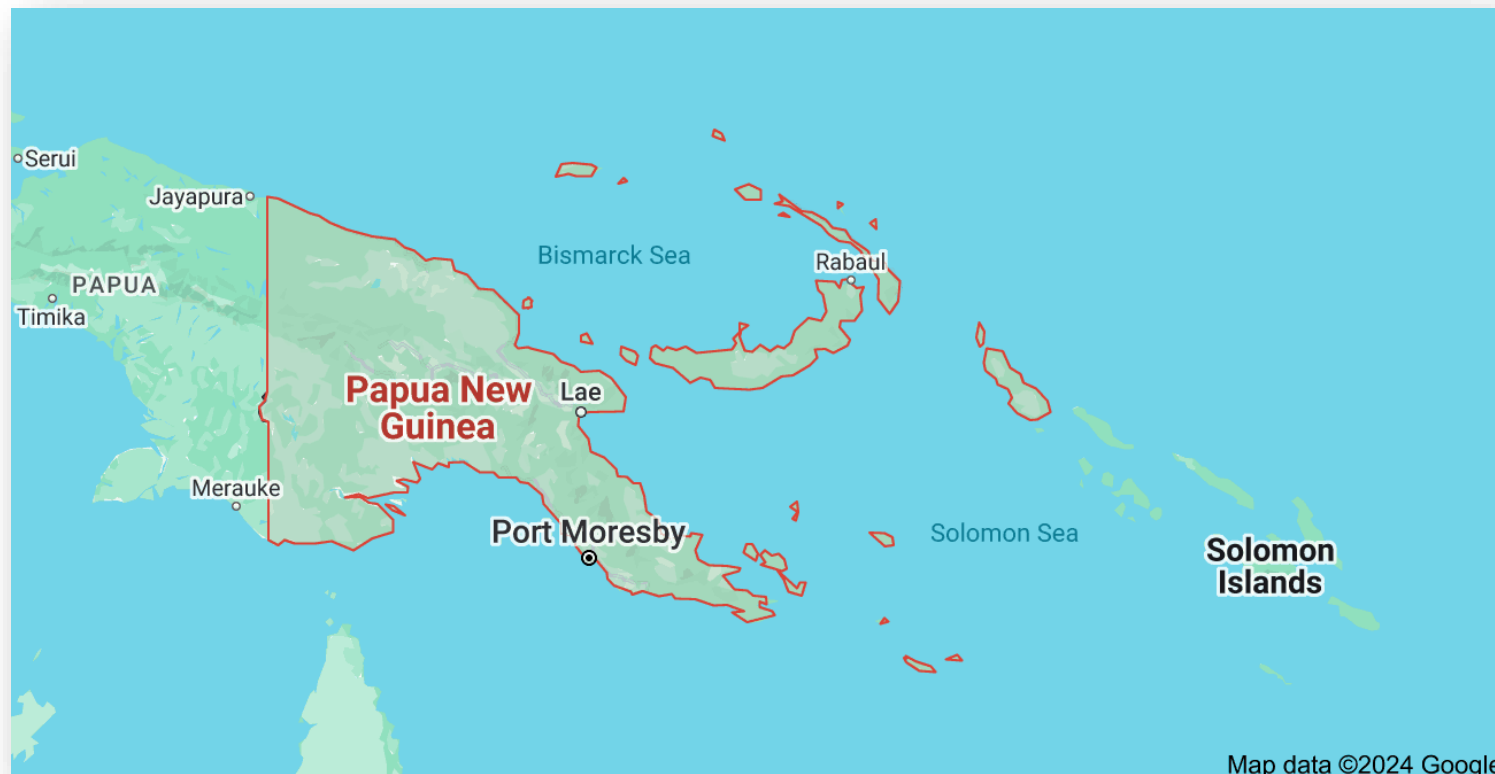

# PAPUA NEW GUINEA - COUNTRY PROFILE



- ✓ Population - >11 million
- ✓ Gross domestic product US\$31 billion
- ✓ 2024 budget approximately US\$7.67 billion
- ✓ Estimated procurement is US\$2.38 billion
- ✓ Papua New Guinea is the most linguistically diverse country in the world, with 840 living languages
- ✓ Land area - 462,840 km<sup>2</sup>



# INTRODUCTION TO PUBLIC PROCUREMENT



## Procurement reform in Papua New Guinea

### Phase 1

- ✓ National Procurement Commission (NPC) was established under National Procurement Act (NPA) of 2018, and became operational on 1st April 2019.
- ✓ NPC supports procurement of above threshold requirements
- ✓ NPA established Provincial, Districts and Special Procurement Committees to procure Works, Goods and Services within their threshold levels.

### Phase 2

- ✓ Digital transformation of procurement using e-GP

# CURRENT STATUS



With TA support from ADB the NPC started an e-GP project design study in June 2024 and has:

- ✓ Allocated funding for the project
- ✓ Established an e-GP steering committee and appointed a project team
- ✓ Documented the current state and used a rapid process improvement workshop to identify improvements
- ✓ Carried out extensive stakeholder consultations
- ✓ Undertaken a readiness assessment for e-GP

# PROJECT TIMELINES



- ✓ Developed a problem statement and vision for e-GP – July 2024
- ✓ Documented future state with an e-GP strategy - October 2024
- ✓ Created an e-GP roadmap - October 2024
- ✓ Engaged with e-GP vendors using an RFI - November 2024
- ✓ Preparing an e-GP system specification and RFP – November 2024 – January 2025
- ✓ NPC will go to tender for an e-GP system in early 2025
