Overview of ECWA projects in Health and Education

1. TÜRKIYE:

Health Infrastructure Enhancement, Lifesaving Medical Advancements (HILAL)

- Program aims to strengthen disaster-resilient hospital infrastructure in earthquake-prone regions.
- Estimated ADB financing: USD 700 million;
- Government co-financing: USD 134 million.
- Planned approval by October 2026, implementation through 2033.



Continued:

During 2026–2027, the procurement will focus on large-scale civil works and medical facility equipment, including:

- Construction of 8 hospital facilities
- New greenfield hospitals (100–600 beds each).
- sites include Balıkesir, Bursa, Bolu, Tekirdağ, Van, İzmir Menemen, Adıyaman.
- Incorporation of seismic and climate-resilience standards.

Hospital Equipment & Furnishing:

- Medical and diagnostic equipment
- ICT systems
- Research and training equipment
- Hospital furniture, WASH installations



2. TAJKISTAN:

Integrated Regional Health Security and Primary Health Care Services Project

- The project strengthens Tajikistan's health security and primary healthcare by improving disease surveillance, expanding laboratory capacity, and building climate-resilient health and GBV service facilities.
- The project will procure and/or construct a total of 42 health facilities and laboratories—comprising 18 integrated laboratories, 9 health container units, 12 PHC facilities, and 2 GBV shelters—costing a combined \$33.47 million in base costs within a total project envelope of \$35.71 million.



3. KYRGYZSTAN:

Seismic Resilience and Learning Environments of Education Infrastructure

Infrastructure upgrades of :

- Up to 8 TVET institutions
- Up to 40 general secondary schools offering new skills tracks

The project will integrate:

- Seismic strengthening
- Climate & energy-resilient features
- Fire safety
- Accessibility
- Gender-responsive design



Continued:

Equipment Procurement - Modern training equipment for TVET centers:

- ICT and smart classrooms
- Technical training equipment
- Disaster and climate resilience equipment for schools
- Digital management systems (EMIS enhancements)

Timeline: October 2026–October 2031

Amount: \$49 million, including \$10 million Gov

Procurement approach: Using country systems due to RBL modality



4. UZBEKISTAN:

Modernization of Vocational Education for Green Economy Project

- Focused on green-economy transition and skills development.
- Investment project (loan) including infrastructure, equipment, curricula, and private sector engagement.
- Targets 90+ TVET institutions and multiple State Technical Universities (STUs).
- Loan amount: \$ 100 million
- Lending modality: project loan



5. MONGOLIA:

Provincial Health Service Strengthening & Modernization Sector Project

- **Civil Works Procurement** : International OCB (Works): 1 contract valued at \$34.5 million
- **National OCB (Works)**: 30 contracts valued at \$51.94 million
- Construction of New 300-bed Aimag Hospital (Outpatient, inpatient, emergency care, Diagnostics, laboratory, Climate- and gender-responsive infrastructure)
- Construction of Annex Facilities (Advanced Emergency & Trauma Units)
- Emergency Department Expansion & Reorganization
- Upgrading Operating Theatres (HVAC & Specialized Fit-outs)
- Construction of 11 New Soum Health Centers



Continued:

Goods Procurement

- International OCB (Equipment): 4 contracts valued at \$44.26 million
- National OCB (Equipment): 17 contracts valued at \$59.90 million

This includes:

- Medical Equipment Procurement across 19 Aimag Hospitals & 5 Soum Centers
- Digital Health & Telemedicine Equipment across All aimag hospitals + select soum health centers
- 19 Ambulances & Emergency Equipment
- Timeline: 2027-2028
