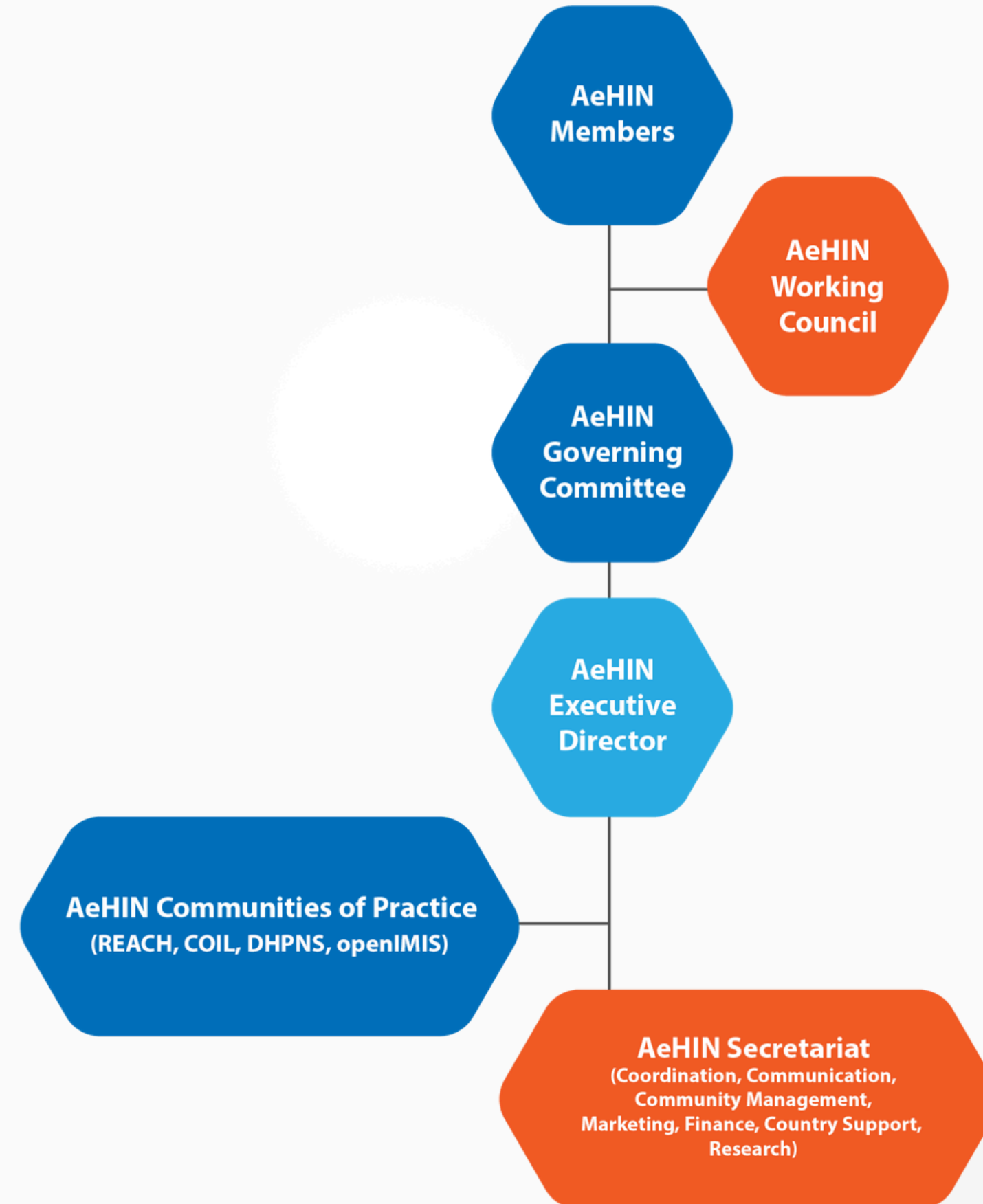

capacities at the Ministry of Health, national digital health authorities, private sector, academia, and not-for-profit organizations, explored different country situations in crafting a digital health call to action for the governments, outlining specific steps based on AaHIN's Mind the GAPS and Fill the GAPS framework.

This call to action is to encourage the regional and regional countries to take immediate steps that could improve the design and implementation of digital health strategies to propel the overall digital health maturity to the next stage, regardless of their current level of maturity. Stakeholders encompass the private, academic, and non-governmental sectors, including international development partners. If the call is acted upon proactively, countries can aim to onboard various health and non-health stakeholders and have a harmonized digital ecosystem that integrates digital health with the country's overall digital infrastructure. It will also ensure accountability for actions, build capacity and ownership among accountable people, promote multi-sector coordination, and ensure innovation.

The call to action is based on AaHIN's GAPS framework, and five calls to action cover the areas of Governance, Architecture, Law, People and Program Management, and Standards and Interoperability.

The Asia eHealth Information Network (AeHIN) officially launched its HL7 FHIR Fundamentals Training on 5 June 2025 and ended on 15 July 2025. This marks the first time AeHIN organized an official Fast Healthcare Interoperability Resources (FHIR) training directly from HL7. The initiative stems from a regional partnership agreement signed between AeHIN and HL7 International, effective from May 2024 to December 2025.

# Lessons from 15 years of networking

- 1. Country ownership is non-negotiable.**
- 2. Peer-to-peer learning outlasts top-down technical assistance and leaderships changes.**
- 3. A network must pulse continuously, not just convene annually.**
- 4. Standards are the connective tissue.**
- 5. Training builds both capacity and community.**
- 6. Openness and FOSS lower barriers to participation.**
