- Fiji hosts one of the largest and most diverse infrastructure pipelines in the Pacific, creating sustained opportunities for regional and international partners.

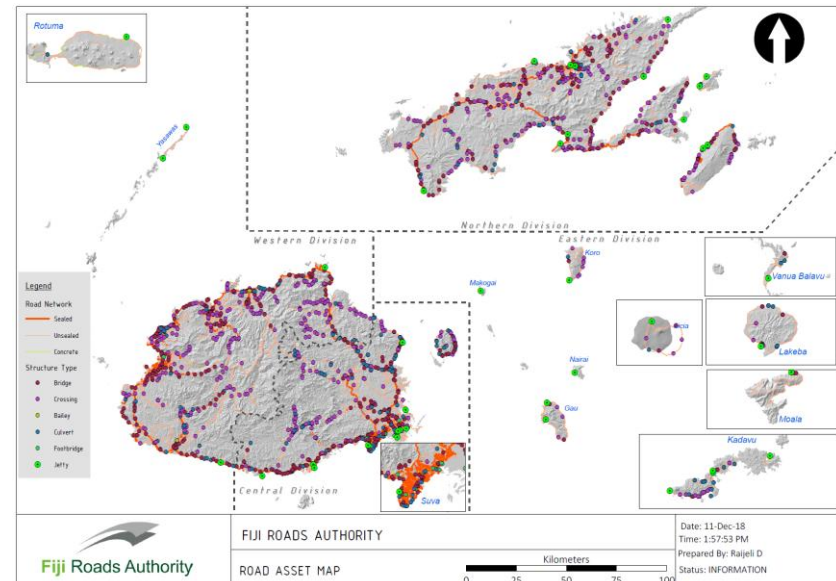
Pipeline Snapshot

Scale & Outlook :

- ~USD 600 million under advanced planning to imminent procurement
- ~USD 580 million expected over the next two years

Indicative Sector Split:

- Energy ~60%
- Transport ~20%
- Water & sanitation ~20%
