Priority projects in the Pipeline

- Power Utilities currently have US\$100 million in donor grant funding being implemented
 - Grid reliability and distribution upgrades
 - Majuro & Ebeye RE integration
- Water Utilities currently have US\$100 million in donor grant funding being implemented
 - Sewer & Water system upgrades, Ocean outfall
- New Hospitals at two locations- currently under design
- Education facilities
- Civil and Marine works
 - Port facility upgrades, Shore protection works
 - Roading works

How the Government wants to work with the Market

- Purpose: Shape bidder behavior early.
- Strong preference for **Joint ventures and local partnerships**
- Opportunities for local firms in **civil works, logistics and O&M**
- Workforce development and skill transfer are **valued**
- Procurement aligned with **ADB and WB Donor Standards-**
Transparency, competition, safeguards

Key risks & What we're doing about them

- Geographic isolation– Higher logistics costs
- Limited local contractor capacity for large scale works
- Climate exposure affecting design and timeliness
- Land
