- Focus: upcoming World Bank-funded infrastructure projects
- Projects: Nukufetau Port Facility + TNCW Building
- Goal: highlight investment & procurement opportunities



Nukufetau Port Facility – Overview

- Sector: Maritime | Value: US\$83.4M
- Timeline: Design 2026–27 | Tender 2028 | Construction 2029–30
- Procurement: Open Competitive Tender (World Bank)
- Major national infrastructure priority



Nukufetau Port Facility

- Scope: resilient wharf, road, bridge, jetty, cargo & passenger facilities
- Supporting works: utilities & integration with community infrastructure
- Challenges: remote logistics, cyclone risk, contractor availability
- Opportunities: JV partnerships, skills transfer, local employment

TNCW Project & Procurement Approach`

- TNCW Building (~USD 780K): women’s empowerment & community use
- Scope: demolition, new facility, utilities, rainwater system
- Timeline: Tender 2026 | Construction 2026–27
- Procurement: WB OCT via STEP + national channels
- Seeking: experienced contractors, partnerships, local engagement
