Bangladesh Facts

ADB's Work in Bangladesh

ADB has been a major source of external assistance to Bangladesh, providing an average of \$2 billion per year since 2016. ADB assistance is aligned with Bangladesh's Eighth Five-Year Plan, 2021–2025, and Perspective Plan, 2021–2041.

To date, ADB has committed 726 public sector loans, grants, and technical assistance totaling \$31.8 billion to Bangladesh. ADB's current sovereign portfolio in Bangladesh includes 75 loans and 4 grants worth \$13 billion.

Brief Description of the Project:

The Government of Bangladesh requested assistance from Asian Development Bank (ADB) to finance the upgrading of 36 kilometers of existing track from Chattogram to Dohazari, new construction of 2.5 km of track, and procure 30 meter-gauge locomotives. The upgrade of tracks will increase the operational speed of the trains, while the purchase of new locomotives enables Bangladesh Railway to increase the frequency of services of the corridor which will result in transferring traffic from buses and trucks to the rail system, and thus, reduces travel time of passengers and freight.

Brief Description of Goods and Related Services, Works or Consulting Services to be Procured and related justification for advance action:

All procurement of goods, works and consulting services will be undertaken in accordance with ADB's Procurement Policy and Procurement Regulations for ADB Borrowers (July 2017, as amended from time to time).

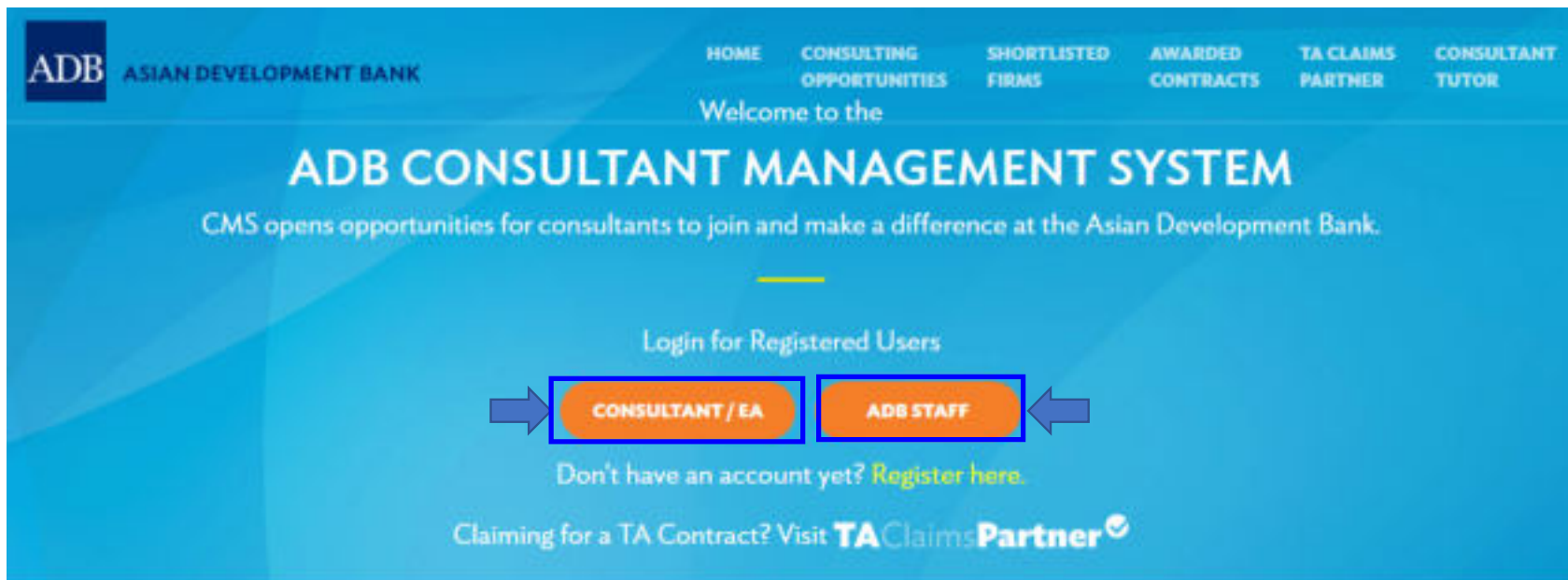



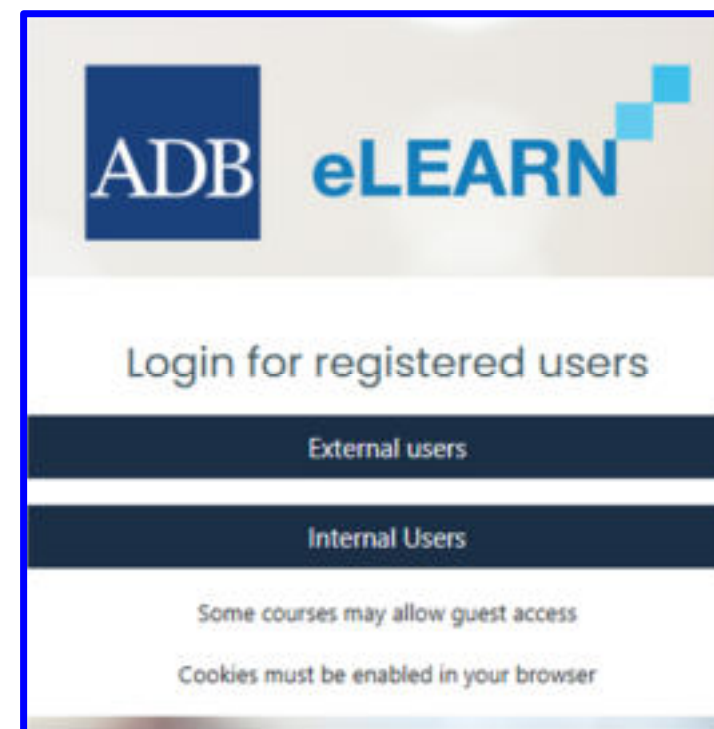
